When it comes to the Google search box, you already know the tricks: finding exact phrases matches using quotes like "so say we all" or searching a single site using site:lifefhacker.com gmail. But there are many more oblique, clever, and lesser-known search recipes and operators that work from that unassuming little input box. Dozens of Google search guides detail the tips you already know, but today we're skipping the obvious and highlighting our favorite obscure Google web search tricks.10. Get the local time anywhere What time is it in Bangkok right now? Ask Google. Enter simply what time is it to get the local time in big cities around the world, or add the locale at the end of your query, like what time is it hong kong to get the local time there.9. Track flight status Enter the airline and flight number into the Google search box and get back the arrival and departure times right inside Google's search results.8. Convert currency, metrics, bytes, and more Google's powerful built-in converter calculator can help you out whether you're cooking dinner, traveling abroad, or building a PC. Find out how many teaspoons are in a quarter cup (quarter cup in teaspoons) or how many seconds there are in a year (seconds in a year) or how many euros there are to five dollars (5 USD in Euro). For the geekier set, bits in kilobytes (155473 bytes in kilobytes) and numbers in hex or binary (19 in binary) are also pretty useful.7. Compare items with "better than" and find similar items with "reminds me of" Reader Adam taps the wisdom of the crowds by searching for like items using key phrases. He writes in:Simply search for, in quotes: "better than keyword "Some example results: Results 1 - 100 of about 550 English pages for " better than WinAmp". Results 1 - 57 of 57 English pages for " better than mIRC". Results 1 - 100 of about 17,500 English pages for " better than Digg". (Wow. Poor Digg.)The results will almost always lead you to discovering alternatives to whatever it is you're searching for. Using the same concept, you can use this trick to discover new music or movies. For example, "reminds me of someband" or "sounds like someband" will pull up artists people have thought sounded similar to the one you typed in. This is also a great way to find good, no-name musicians you'd probably never know of otherwise.Examples: Results 1 - 88 of 88 English pages for " reminds me of Metallica". Results 1 - 36 of 36 English pages for " similar to Garden State". Results 1 - 66 of 66 English pages for " sounds like The Shins". Just get creative and you'll, without a doubt, find cool new stuff you probably never knew existed.6. Use Google as a free proxy What, your company blocks that hip new web site just because it drops the F bomb occasionally? Use Google's cache to take a peek even when the originating site's being blocked, with cache:example.com.5. Remove affiliate links from product searchesWhen you're sick of seeing duplicate product search results from the likes of eBay, Bizrate, Pricerunner, and Shopping.com, clear 'em out by stacking up the -site:ebay.com -site:bizrate.com -site:shopping.com operator. Alternately, check out Give Me Back My Google (original post), a service that does all that known reseller cleaning up for you when you search for products. Find related terms and documentsOk, this one's direct from any straight-up advanced search operator cheat sheet, but it's still one of the lesser-used tricks in the book. Adding a tilde (~) to a search term will return related terms. For example, Googling ~nutrition returns results with the words nutrition, food, and health in them.3. Find music and comic books Using a combination of advanced search operators that specify music files available in an Apache directory listing, you can turn Google into your personal Napster. Go ahead, try this search for Nirvana tracks: -inurl:(html|html|php) intitle:"index of" + "last modified" + "parent directory" +description +size +(wma|mp3) "Nirvana". Pop your term into Google Image Search (or type image:jicama into the regular search box) to see what your term's about.1. Make Google recognize faces If you're doing an image search for Paris Hilton and don't want any of the French city, a special URL parameter in Google's Image search will do the trick. Add &imgtype=face to the end of your image search to just get images of faces, without any inanimate objects. Taking a page from Twitter, Google's new social network, Google+, is releasing two new features that will help users search posts more easily: real-time search results and improved hashtag support. The releases come during a particularly difficult week for Google. An employee accidentally shared an update on Google+ publicly, calling out the execution of Google+ as a "pathetic afterthought" in a public post. Chitka, a data analytics firm, released a report claiming that Google+ traffic has dropped by a whopping 60 percent. Undaunted, Google CEO Larry Page claimed that Google+ was on the right track and has attracted more than 40 million users during a conference call Thursday to discuss the company's third quarter financial results. He also hinted that a bigger Google+ integration into Google's suite of products is coming, saying: Think about it this way: Last quarter, we shipped the 'Plus,' and now we're going to ship the Google part, he said. In a Google+ post, Google's SVP of Engineering, Vic Gundotra, said he hopes these two new features will "make it easier to follow and contribute to live events on Google+, including breaking news, sporting events, and many others." Here's what you need to know about them.Google+: Im Just Not That Into YouGoogle+ Real-Time SearchLast month, Google+ announced the search feature. Now when you search in Google+, you'll see a message about new posts immediately once they're available.To do this, enter a term into the search bar and hit Enter. The results that appear will be the "best posts" on that topic.If you wait a few seconds, depending on how popular your search term is, you'll notice a box appear on the top that denotes the most recent posts related to your search term—very similar to how Twitter streams function. Click it to begin streaming the results in real-time. To pause the stream, just click the Pause button in the top-right, and click Play to resume real-time streaming.Google+ hashtags function the same way that Twitter hashtags do. Use the (#) symbol to categorize a post. Once you share it, Google+ will automatically link the hashtag to search results. You dont need to use hashtags on Google+ since search will work without them. If you don't notice the new features yet, you should receive them soon. Google's Gundotra says that both features are rolling out gradually. But it's not the only search engine out there, and in fact, many of them can offer something that Google doesn't: Privacy. Contents StartpageDuckDuckGoBraveQwantMicrosoft Bing Here are some of the best alternatives to Google Search, with a collection of useful features and the option of remaining entirely anonymous, no matter what you're looking for. Startpage Startpage is a Dutch search engine that was officially launched in 2002 after being merged with its sister company, Ixquick. It has privacy as one of its unique selling points and promises that it doesn't store your personal information. It also claims that it doesn't track, log, or share your search history. Since Startpage doesn't store your previously-searched data, it does not show targeted advertisements based on it. The ads that you see on the site are strictly contextual based on the keywords you use to search for something. This privacy-oriented search engine also leverages an Anonymous View feature that allows you to perform searches through proxy for an extra layer of security. A primary reason behind Startpage not being as artificial intelligence (A.I.)-loaded as Google is because it is based in the Netherlands and is protected by the privacy laws of the European Union. Hence, it isn't victim to programs such as PRISM, a surveillance program from the U.S. However, it is important to note that the

information that you provide on these sites isn't completely protected from external eyes. The Nine Eyes, an intelligence alliance working with Denmark, France, the Netherlands, and Norway, facilitates the sharing of information between the different countries. Companies headquartered in those countries can be compelled to share user data with their agencies, which in turn share it with other countries. That's not to say there is much to share, but it's important to take into account when your privacy is paramount. DuckDuckGo DuckDuckGo, like Startpage, is another search engine that has privacy as one of its primary distinguishing features. It promises the protection of your personal information and search data, thus guaranteeing that it won't trap you in filter bubbles of highly customized search results. By profiling users, sites such as Google create a prototype of your identity in their databases. The faux identities that the sites create are not only highly reductionist in nature but also incomplete, stereotypical, and generalizing. DuckDuckGo's main premise is that it doesn't profile its consumers in categories and shows everyone all the available search results for a keyword on which a search is performed. Similar to Startpage, DuckDuckGo also shows ads based on keywords, unlike Google, which uses past data and user patterns to choose which ads to show. The revenue the site earns is through affiliate relationships with Amazon and eBay. Brave Brave is another privacy-focused search engine that was recently launched and has its headquarters in San Francisco. Based on the Chromium browser, it is open-source software that gives you a free license to use, copy, study, and change it in any way. Its source code is openly shared, encouraging you to voluntarily improve its design. Because of Brave's unique structure, it has successfully garnered more than 32 million active monthly users. Like the other search engines on this list, Brave also prides itself on its privacy settings. It blocks site trackers and online ads as a part of its default settings. However, another very interesting feature of this search engine is that it features optional ads, which you're paid to watch. Payment is made in the form of a cryptocurrency known as Basic Attention Tokens or BAT. You then have the option to use this currency to pay sites or your favorite content creators. You can also simply keep the money for yourself. Brave Search is available globally on all Brave browsers (desktop, Android, and iOS) as one of the search options alongside other search engines and will become the default search in the Brave browser later this year. It is also available from any other browser at search.brave.com. Qwant Qwant, launched in July 2013, is a France-based search engine that also aims to keep you from being stuck in personalization hell. Operated from Paris, Qwant is also subject to the stringent privacy laws of the European Union, just as Startpage is, and guards your data according to the General Data Protection Regulation passed in 2018. The French website has its own indexing engine and promises that it doesn't keep track of your search history. Available in 26 languages, Qwant now processes more than 10 million search requests per day and more than 50 million users a month. According to its privacy policy, Qwant "does not collect data about its users when they search." It also claims it doesn't make use of any cookies or trackers. An interesting feature Qwant offers is limiting third-party sites' insight into your search data. This means the websites providing results do not see what you search for, thus staying oblivious of your online identity, behavior, and search patterns. It is worth mentioning that Qwant is a part of the Five Eyes intelligence alliance. It doesn't necessarily mean it isn't private, but it isn't quite as protected from oversight as ones hosted outside the reach of these networks. Microsoft Bing Previously known as Bing, Microsoft Bing is a search engine launched in 2009 and owned and run by, as the name suggests, Microsoft. Just like Google does, Bing provides web, video, image, and map results. Bing claims it doesn't track your search activities like Google does. It uses HTTPS that enables it to respond to your search queries securely. It also promises that it provides end-to-end encryption to offer extra security and make sure no third-party apps are using your data for their own advantage. Bing's unique feature is an option to sign in to an enterprise account, which could mean your work or school account. Bing never associates your search data with your workplace identity, nor does it provide you with targeted ads based on it. Microsoft is based in the U.S., so it can be compelled to share data with law enforcement agencies if requested to do so. Editors' Recommendations
